Talking Points

- This bill betrays the agreement for withdrawing Initiative Petition 9 in exchange for passage of HB 4024 and agreeing to work on technical fixes without policy changes.
- The bill allows large special interest organizations to continue dominating campaign finance in Oregon while still limiting individual contributors.
- It substantially erodes the financial disclosure requirements and further delays their implementation for 3 years.
- The wording was developed in secret without collaboration with good government groups or national experts.

Legislative Priority

PROTECT DEMOCRACY by protecting privacy and voting rights - including automatic registration. Fund and implement secure, efficient election software, supporting ranked choice voting. Protect against mis-, dis-, and mal-information, including from artificial intelligence. Ensure cybersecurity. Defend and support the implementation of HB 4024 (2023) on campaign finance.
